

Privacy Policy

Delfino Madden O'Malley Coyle & Koewler LLP ("**Delfino Madden**" or "**We**") respects your privacy, and we are committed to protecting it through our compliance with this Privacy Policy. This Policy describes the types of information we may collect from you or that you may provide when you visit the website www.delfinomadden.com (our "**Website**") and our practices for collecting, using, maintaining, protecting, and disclosing that information.

This policy applies to information we collect:

- On this Website.
- In email, text, and other electronic messages between you and this Website.

It does not apply to information collected by or provided to Delfino Madden:

- Offline or through any other means, including via email to any Delfino Madden attorneys or personnel; or
- By any third party, including through any application or content (including advertising) that may link to or be accessible from the Website.

Please read this Policy carefully to understand our policies and practices regarding your information and how we will treat it. If you do not agree with our policies and practices, your choice is not to use our Website. By accessing or using this Website, you agree to this Policy. This Policy may change from time to time (see [Changes to Our Privacy Policy](#)). Children Under the Age of 13

Information We Collect About You and How We Collect It

We may collect several types of information from and about users of our Website, including information:

- by which you may be personally identified, such as name, e-mail address, and telephone number ("**personal information**");
- that is about you but individually does not identify you by name, such as the aggregated number of visitors to our Website, and/or technical information such as internet protocol (IP) addresses, and Website traffic data.

Information You Provide to Us. The information we collect on or through our Website may include:

- Information that you provide by filling in a contact form on our Website. We may also ask you for information when you report a problem with our Website.

- Records and copies of your correspondence (including email addresses) if you contact us via the Website.

Information We Collect Through Automatic Data Collection Technologies.

We do not use technologies to collect information about your online activities over time and across third-party websites or other online services (behavioral tracking) and therefore our Website does not respond to Do Not Track (DNT) signals. The information we collect automatically is statistical data and does not include personal information and we do not maintain it or associate it with personal information we collect in other ways or receive from third parties. It helps us to improve our Website by enabling us to estimate our audience size and usage patterns.

Third-Party Use of Cookies and Other Tracking Technologies.

Links to other websites on the Website are served by third parties, including advertisers, ad networks and servers, content providers, and application providers. These third parties may use cookies alone or in conjunction with web beacons or other tracking technologies to collect information about you when you visit their websites. We do not control these third parties' tracking technologies or how they may be used. How We Use Your Information

We use information that we collect about you or that you provide to us, including any personal information:

- To present our Website and its contents to you.
- To provide you with information that you request from us.
- To fulfill any other purpose for which you provide it.
- To notify you about changes to our Website or any events we offer or provide through it.
- To notify you of new articles or blog posts or to provide updates on current events, laws or regulations if you have provided your e-mail address to us or have subscribed for such communications.
- In any other way we may describe when you provide the information.
- For any other purpose with your consent.

Disclosure of Your Information

We do not share or sell your personal information with any unaffiliated third parties for advertising purposes.

We may disclose aggregated information about our users, and information that does not identify any individual, without restriction. We may disclose personal information that we collect or that you provide as described in this Policy:

- To contractors, service providers, and other third parties we use to support our business and who are bound by contractual obligations to keep personal information confidential and use it only for the purposes for which we disclose it to them.
- For any other purpose disclosed by us when you provide the information.
- With your consent.

We may also disclose your personal information:

- To comply with any court order, law, or legal process, including to respond to any government or regulatory request.
- If we believe disclosure is necessary or appropriate to protect the rights, property, or safety of Delfino Madden, our attorneys and personnel, or others. This includes exchanging information with other companies and organizations for the purposes of fraud protection and credit risk reduction.

Choices About How We Use and Disclose Your Information

We strive to provide you with choices regarding the personal information you provide to us. We have created mechanisms to provide you with the following control over your information:

- **Email Communications.** If you do not wish to be contacted by Delfino Madden at the e-mail address you provide, you can opt-out by [e-mailing us](#) or selecting “unsubscribe” on the e-mail we sent. This opt out does not apply to information provided to Delfino Madden as a result of an attorney-client relationship or for direct responses to a request you submitted to us.
